Some phobias are very interesting; there are: Ailurophobia-Fear of cats, Anglophobia-Fear of England, Aurophobia- Fear of gold, Bibliophobia-Fear of books, Ecophobia- Fear of home, Logophobia- Fear of words, Cheatophobia-Fear of hair, Nomatophobia-Fear of names. The names of these phobias are also interesting, aren't they?

Some phobias can change our lifestyle. For example : if you have Dendrophobia(Fear of trees) you can't walk in the forest or even in the garden.
