#### The Masmak Fort

The Masmak Fort is considered to be one of the most important sites in the centre of Riyadh. It was built around 1865 by Mohammed bin Abdullah bin Rasheed and came under the control of King Abdulaziz in 1902. Its architecture is a typical sample of Saudi Arabian culture and tradition. The word masmak means strong and thick, and this is why it was used not only as a palace but as a fort as well.
